





WELCOME TO AUCKLAND

Auckland is New Zealand's largest city with well over 1.3 million people and it is the commercial heart of the country. Auckland is renowned as "The City of Sails" and has more boats per capita than any other city in the world. With a wide range of shops, cafes, restaurants and entertainment venues, it is a cosmopolitan, multi-cultural and exciting city.

Auckland is full of parks and places of interest. In the Mercer Consulting 2008 international quality of living survey, Auckland was ranked (tied 4th) Top City in the world. Auckland has a mild climate, with four seasons. Spring (September to November): 10-22°C; Summer (December to February): 14-28°C; Autumn (March to May): 12-24°C; and Winter (June to August): 7-16°C. Rain falls at any time during the year, but mostly during winter.

Travelling around Auckland is relatively easy. Public transport coverage is provided by buses, trains and harbour ferries.



ENGLISH

GENERAL ENGLISH & IELTS PREPARATION

AWI-International Education Group offers flexibility in its English classes to meet different students' requirements. Some students may simply wish to improve their general English skills over a period of a few weeks. Others may wish to study up to a year to achieve high scores in the IELTS examinations.

Each level of the General English is designed to provide three months of English language study. However, the duration may vary for individual students. The curriculum covers the four linguistic skills (Speaking, Listening, Reading and Writing) with outcomes specified to each skill over all class levels.

The course is structured in the following levels:

General English

Elementary
Pre-Intermediate
Intermediate

Academic English

Advanced and IELTS preparation students will reach the level of communication in English they individually seek in order to achieve their goals in further studies, recreation or personal interests.

Entry Requirements

At least 16 years of age and be familiar with the English alphabet.

COMPUTING

NATIONAL DIPLOMA IN COMPUTING – LEVEL 5

AWI - International Education Group offers the National Diploma in Computing (Level 5) programme completed in 1 academic year of full time study. The course provides a thorough grounding in both technical and organisational aspects of computing. The course structure and unit credits are such that students will graduate with specialisation in Computer Support.

On successful completion of the programme, Graduates will have an extensive range of knowledge and skills across key elements of computing like Computer Management, Computer Operations, Programming and non-technical areas relevant to computing including: Ethics, Professionalism, and the Role of Computing in Business.

This is a comprehensive stand alone course designed for graduates who

either wish to enter the workforce, or pathway to a level 6 or level 7 programme.

Additional academic classes and English tuitions are available on request.

Entry Requirements


Completion of Year 12, computer experience at an application user level such as MS Office, an IELTS minimum of 5.5 or internationally recognised equivalent.

Note: If necessary, tuition for English as a second language is available at AWI for international students.

Visa Opportunities

Students will have up to one year student visa with work permit of 20 hours weekly.

COMPUTING

DIPLOMA IN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY - LEVEL 7

AWI-International Education Group offers this programme of twelve units. Eight core units are compulsory. Four core units are designed to achieve knowledge and skills in designing, installing and testing single user computers and multi-user networks.

Four core units develop skills in project management, user training, technical documentation, and ability to make presentations. Three optional sets of units make up the remaining four units and refine the application of skills and knowledge into specialist strands of: *Computer Operations & Support, Computer Networks, and Web Design & Development.*

Graduates will have an extensive knowledge and skills across key elements of computing with skills to apply knowledge in the optional strand they select. This will equip them to enter immediately into a productive role within an organisation

or progress into further study in specialist areas. Additional academic classes and English tuitions are available on request


Entry Requirements

Entry requirements for International students are defined as age 18 or older, completion of a Computing or Information Technology qualification at Level 5 or higher, and an IELTS minimum of 6.0 or internationally recognised equivalent.

Visa opportunity

Students are eligible to work part time 20 hours weekly. After graduating the students may be eligible to apply for Post Study Work Visa which allows for full time employment for up to 12 months.

COMPUTING

DIPLOMA IN COMPUTER SCIENCE & IT - LEVEL 7

AWI - International Education Group offers Diploma in Computer Science and IT Level 7 as a 1 academic year course of full time study.

On completion, graduates will have an extensive range of knowledge and skills across key elements of computing with skills to apply knowledge in the optional strand they select. On successful completion of the programme, graduates can choose to enter into employment or pathway onto further study in specialist areas.

The programme provides in-depth training in the research, design, installation, commissioning and testing of computer networks and stand-alone systems. It develops students' self directed learning abilities and also produces graduates able to apply knowledge in their selected elective area of *Computer Operations & Support* and *Computer Networks*.

Additional academic classes and English tuitions are available on request.

Entry Requirements


Applicants are required to hold a diploma Level 5 qualification in computing OR demonstrate or provide evidence of equivalent knowledge and skills. Students may also be required to undertake a pre entry test or interview or both to determine their suitability for the programme.

International students from non-English speaking countries must have an IELTS score of 6.0 with no bandscore lower than 5.5 acquired in the one examination within the past two years or equivalent test as approved by NZQA

Visa opportunity

Students are eligible to work part time 20 hours weekly. After graduating the students may be eligible to apply for Post Study Work Visa which allows for full time employment for up to 12 months.

AWI DIPLOMA IN BUSINESS - LEVEL 7

Qualification: On successful completion of the Programme, students will be awarded the AWI Diploma in Business Management (Level 7).

Entry Requirements

Available to graduates of the Level 6 Diploma in Business or related areas and/or appropriate related work experience or equivalent.

International students from non-English speaking countries must also have an IELTS minimum of 6.0 or internationally recognised equivalent.


Visa opportunity

Students are eligible to work part time 20 hours weekly. After graduating the students can request the Post Study Work Visa (open) which allows for full time employment for a maximum of 12 months.



Students are entitled to 24 hours emergency contact with homestays.

YOUTH HOSTEL/BACKPACKER HOSTEL

You can also stay at a youth or backpacker hostel. There is a great variety of hostels/backpackers in Auckland and you can choose the one that will suit you the best. The prices vary according to the number of people you are sharing your room with (from NZ\$ 25 per night).

Each hostel has a big kitchen for everyone to use, shared bathrooms and a lounge where everyone meets to spend time together.

Hostels/backpackers have mostly dorm rooms where 4-6 people share same room with bunk beds. These are usually for people travelling through the city for shorter periods of time. For long term accommodation, this is not recommended especially for overseas students as they need to concentrate on their study.

Sometimes it is possible to have a private room or share with one more person (from \$80 per night). Free or paid wifi is available.

If you want to stay in a hostel, contact us for further information, we can help you to find the most suitable to your needs and book it for you.



HOSTEL/SHARED APARTMENT

A different option is available for students who want to live in a smaller place with other international students. The owners of this accommodation take special care about the welfare of students, cleanliness and proper functioning of the structure of the accommodation. A major advantage is a central location and the possibility of sharing an apartment with students from different parts of the world.

COMPUTER LAB & FREE WI-FI


The Computer lab is available for all the students. Students can access their emails, do their assignments or just surf the net. Printing is available for student use. We have free Wi-Fi available in the Campus.
