New Zealand Certificate in Information Technology Level 5

Fundamental to get your career in IT started



OVERVIEW

This qualification provides the core skills for the professions in website development and design. Graduates will be capable of applying the fundamentals of current and emerging concepts and practice in building a complete web application.

They will also be able to demonstrate an awareness of appropriate professional practice, and work both as part of a team and independently under broad supervision. It will equip people for further IT related study, and may also prepare people for employment in an entry level IT role.

ENTRY CRITERIA

Open entry with interview. Preference will be given to students with qualifications in Information Technology Level 3 and 4.

English Requirement: International students whose first language is not English must provide evidence of competency in English language equivalent to IELTS 5.5 (Academic) with no band less than 5.0 or NZSE's Internal English Test.

Diploma in Information Technology Level 6

Your pathway to success - Bachelor Degree pathway



OVERVIEW

This two-year programme of study focuses on the theory and practice of a range of computing systems and networks, and how these systems are used to support business practices. It aims to produce graduates with a sound technical understanding of information technology and the application of IT to business information systems. The course has an emphasis on developing skills in problem solving, interpersonal communication and addressing IT problems in a range of contexts.

The programme's core is the fundamentals of information systems, hardware and software infrastructure, user applications and communication. In the second year students are able to specialise in networking or user support.

Academic Entry Criteria: High School qualification

English Entry Criteria: International students whose first language is not English must provide evidence of competency in English language equivalent to IELTS 6.0 (Academic) with no band less than 5.0 or successful completion of NZSE's Internal English Test.

This programme gives students knowledge of planning, designing and implementing the installation of a network operating system and application software for the network.

Students learn installation and configuration of computer operating systems; network topologies and practical implementation of networks and servers; Configuration of services, protocols; Industry standard backup and disaster recovery procedures; latest cloud Technologies; Communications and Infrastructure security and the methods to bolster network and cloud security to protect against malicious hacking activities.



OVERVIEW

This Certificate provides students with a six-month programme of study in academic skills. These focus on introducing students to the requirements of academic study at a tertiary level. It aims to produce graduates who are capable of undertaking academic studies in the field of their choice.

The core modules are designed to introduce students to the rigours of studying at a tertiary level. Upon completion of the programme, students can pathway into various NZ and Australian Universities and Polytechnics.

ENTRY CRITERIA

Entry to this programme is open, provided applicants meet requirements in speaking, listening, reading and writing as assessed at an interview.

- **English Entry Criteria:** International students whose first language is not English must provide evidence of competency in English language equivalent to IELTS 5.5 (Academic) with no band less than 5.0 or successful completion of NZSE's Internal English Test.

Upon completion of the programme, students can pathway into various NZ & Australian Universities and Polytechnics.

ENTRY CRITERIA

Entry to this programme is open, provided applicants meet requirements in speaking, listening, reading and writing as assessed at an interview.

- **English Entry Criteria:** International students whose first language is not English must provide evidence of competency in English language equivalent to IELTS 5.5 (Academic) with no band less than 5.0 or successful completion of NZSE's Internal English Test.



Caring for the next generation



OVERVIEW

The programme will give students introductory knowledge and skills to educate and care for infants, toddlers and young children.

It covers health and safety, nutrition, parenting, communication, guiding behavior and how to plan education programmes for children from birth to school age.

ENTRY CRITERIA

There are no mandatory entry requirements for this programme. However, before enrolment students are required to fulfil the requirements of the Vulnerable Children's Act 2014, safety check which includes:
