SEAFIELD COURSES

Seafield English language tuition offers the following:

FULL-TIME GENERAL ENGLISH

Our General English courses are available **full-time** from beginner to advanced, and consist of lessons covering grammar, vocabulary, reading, writing, listening & speaking.

Courses start every Monday, 9.00am to 3.00pm for any length from 1 to 50 weeks. Lessons are 23.75 hours/30 lessons per week.

EVENING GENERAL ENGLISH

Our General English courses are available in the **evenings** from beginner to advanced, and consist of lessons covering grammar, vocabulary, reading, writing, listening & speaking.

Courses start every Monday, 4.30pm to 9.30pm for any length from 1 to 50 weeks. Lessons are 23.75 hours/30 lessons per week.

PART-TIME GENERAL ENGLISH

Our General English courses are available **part-time** from beginner to advanced, and consist of lessons covering grammar, vocabulary, reading, writing, listening & speaking.

Courses start every Monday, 9.00am to 12.00pm for any length from 1 to 50 weeks. Lessons are 15 hours/20 lessons per week.

ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSES

English for Academic Purposes (**EAP**) is for students who wish to undertake further tertiary education. This gives students entry into UCIC's University Transfer Programme (UTP) and foundation programme, without the need for IELTS.

Courses start every Monday, 9.00am to 3.00pm for any length from 1 to 50 weeks. Lessons are 23.75 hours/30 lessons per week.

🏠 ARRANGED ACCOMMODATION

Homestay (half board or full board) and other forms of accommodation can be arranged for students within easy travelling distance to the school.

Some students choose to cycle or walk. All accommodation arranged by the school is inspected & selected for suitability to ensure that your time with us is as enjoyable as possible.

📖 OUR LESSONS

On the first day of school, students are given an assessment test and interview, and then placed in classes according to their English ability.

The morning classes focus on grammar, reading, writing and vocabulary development, in addition to speaking and listening, using a variety of up-to-date resources.

The afternoon classes have a particular emphasis on speaking, listening and pronunciation, in the context of everyday communication and topical issues.

Our teachers use a variety of modern teaching techniques, including pair work, small groups, role-play, discussions, debates and computer assisted language learning (CALL).

A certificate is awarded upon graduation. Students on courses of 3 weeks or longer also receive an academic progress report.



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AUCKLAND CITY

With great destinations in a beautiful location, students have access to the culturally-rich Auckland City. New Zealand offers great shopping, exciting nightlife, convenient transport services and a variety of cultural, leisure and sporting activities at all times of the year!

The warmest months are December, January and February, and the coldest June, July and August. In summer, the average maximum temperature ranges between 20-30 Celcius and in winter between 10-15 Celcius.

SEAFIELD ACTIVITIES

Seafield arranges a variety of afterschool and weekend activities for students. Our activity calendars are updated regularly so students can make the most of their time in New Zealand. *(Excursion/activity costs are additional to school fees).*
