Tuition Fee (NCEA or short term students):	NZD \$15,250 per 4 term year / \$3,812.50 per 10 week term
Tuition Fee (IB students):	NZD \$16,750
Administration Fee:	NZD \$1,500 per year
Homestay Fees:	NZD \$280 per week payable in advance (\$300 for 13 year olds)
Homestay Placement Fee:	NZD \$350
Designated Caregiver Administration Fee:	NZD \$250
Homestay Change Administration Fee:	NZD \$150
Special Dietary Requirements:	NZD \$20+ per week depending on requirements
Special Full Report:	NZD \$150
Insurance:	NZD \$500+ per year
Airport Pickup:	Free

Estimated Total Fees

(Estimates include tuition fee, administration fee, homestay fees, homestay placement fee and insurance). Some terms will be slightly more or less depending on the exact number of weeks students will be in the homestay.

One term:	NZD \$8,035

Extra costs not covered are:

- a. Laptop (compulsory for students in Years 9,10, 11 and 12)
- b. Uniform (allow NZD \$300)
- c. Stationery (allow NZD\$100). Workbook costs are included in the tuition fee.
- d. Pocket Money (varies)
- e. School subject trips and field trips (varies)
- f. Travel to, from and within New Zealand
- g. Involvement in extra-curricular activities (all user-pays)
